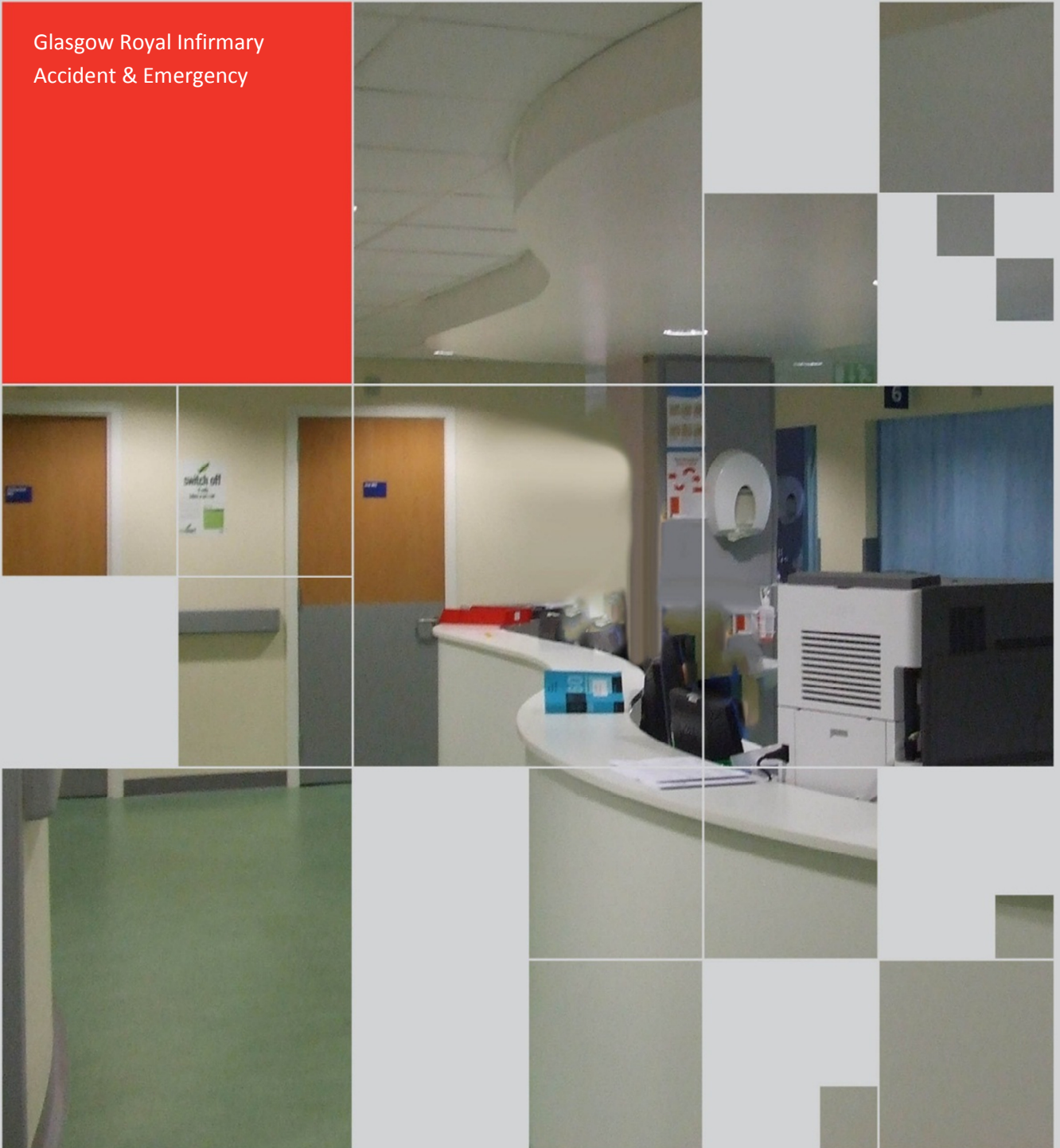
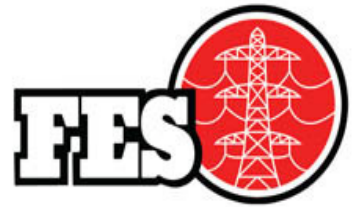

As part of an ongoing modernisation programme at Glasgow Royal Infirmary a new fully refurbished A & E department has been created, providing the hospital with the latest technology for patients to the north and east of NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde's area.

Generally the works which were carried out were within a 'Live' functional building which presented a number of difficult challenges to ensure that hospital could still operate as required whilst the fit-out was being progressed over several phases. This required detailed surveys to be carried out and close consultation with the Estates Department and Design Team prior to setting our operatives to work.

FES carried out the full Electrical Installation, mechanical supplies, door access, door entry, CCTV and fire alarms.
