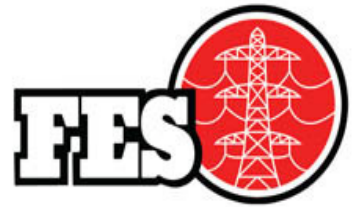

FES Ltd are delighted to have been involved in delivering the showpiece venue for the 2014 Glasgow Commonwealth Games. The project provides two distinctly separate sports arenas under one roof. The multi-function sports arena and Velodrome are linked by a 34m x 80m connecting Hub Building.

The 5,000-seat indoor arena will feature a hydraulically operated 200m running track, jumping and throwing areas, a warm-up straight and sports halls. The 2,000-seat Velodrome will house a 250m high-banked cycle track with multi-use infield area.

FES Ltd are responsible for the Containment Systems, LV Distribution and associated equipment, Standby Generator, General power, Event lighting, Lighting (internal, external & emergency) Lighting controls, Static Inverter, PA/VE with in-house specialist divisions support responsible for the HV Installation, Data / Wi-Fi, Fire & Security, Disabled Alarms & Disabled Refuge Systems.
